

Marking a Cemetery Plot

St. John the Evangelist Catholic Cemetery

Plot

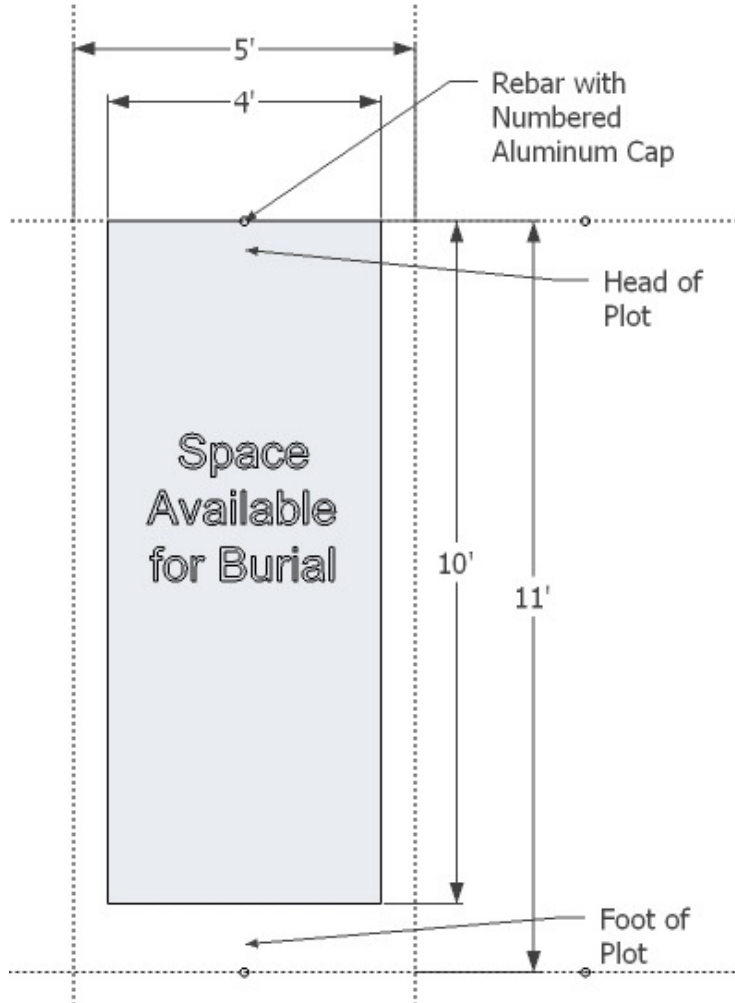
Each plot is 5 feet wide and 11 feet head to foot (see the dotted lines) with a rebar cap* at the top, center of the plot.

*Note that rebar caps are in Section B and Section C, but not in Section A.

Space Available for Burial

The space available for burial is 4 feet wide (centered on the rebar cap). The space is 10 feet top to bottom (with the rebar cap at the top edge). See the gray area.

The space is smaller than the plot size to provide space between adjacent plots.



Marking a Plot

- Find the plot using the cemetery map.

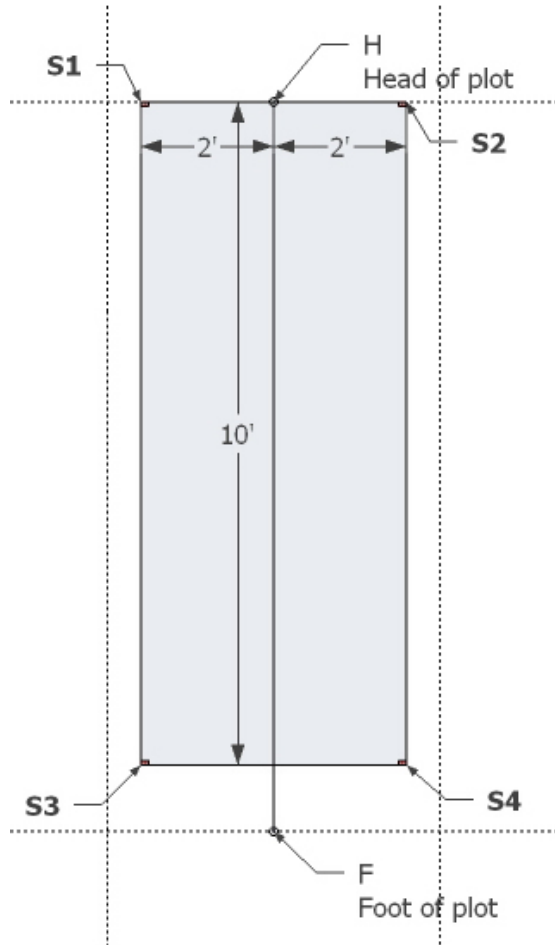
- Locate the rebar cap for the plot. A metal detector is available at the church. *Note: Sections B & C have rebar caps. Section A does NOT have rebar caps.*
- IMPORTANT!** Confirm the plot number on the rebar cap. *Note: Some rebar caps are corroded and the plot number cannot be read. If the number cannot be read, read the number of an adjacent rebar cap.*

Marking a Cemetery Plot

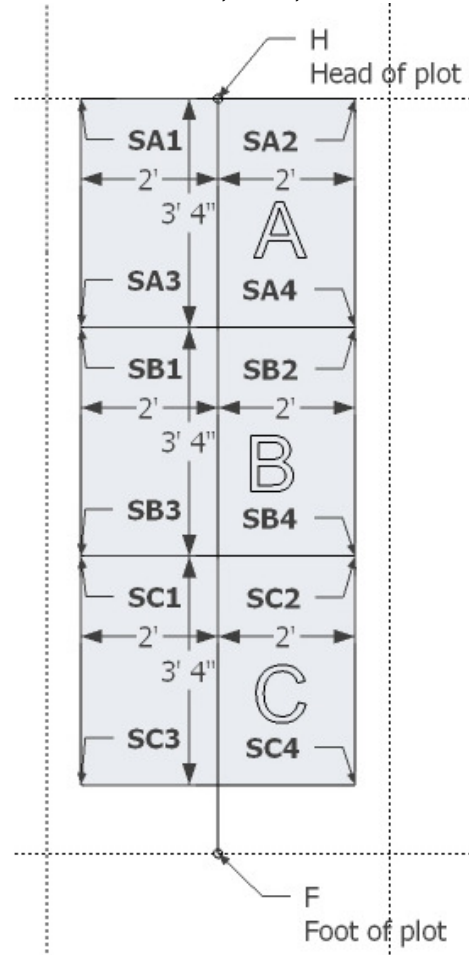
- Use a tape measure or rope to draw a line between the rebar cap at the head of the plot (H) and the rebar cap at the foot of the plot (F).
- **Full Body Burial / Monument Placement**
Placement – Place stakes** S1 and S2 two feet away from rebar cap (H).
• Measure ten feet from rebar cap (H) (toward rebar cap (F)). Place stakes S3 and S4 two feet away from the H-F line as shown.

** Stakes are stored behind the tree at plot B178



- **Cremated Burial / Monument Placement**

- Burial in / Monument in Area "A" – Place stakes** SA1, SA2, SA3 and SA4 as shown.
- Burial in / Monument in Area "B" – Place stakes SB1, SB2, SB3 and SB4.
- Burial in / Monument in Area "C" – Place stakes SC1, SC2, SC3 and SC4.



Mark Name and Plot Number

Place a wreath holder (found behind the tree at plot B178) in the middle of the stakes. Copy the name of the deceased and the plot number from Katherine's email. Put it in a plastic (sandwich) bag. Tape the plastic bag, with name and plot number, to the wreath holder.

Special Marking

If plots are to be marked other than as described above, Katherine Bacon will provide special instructions. For example, in some cases a shared monument may be placed between the heads of two plots.
